and gently lead those that are with young.

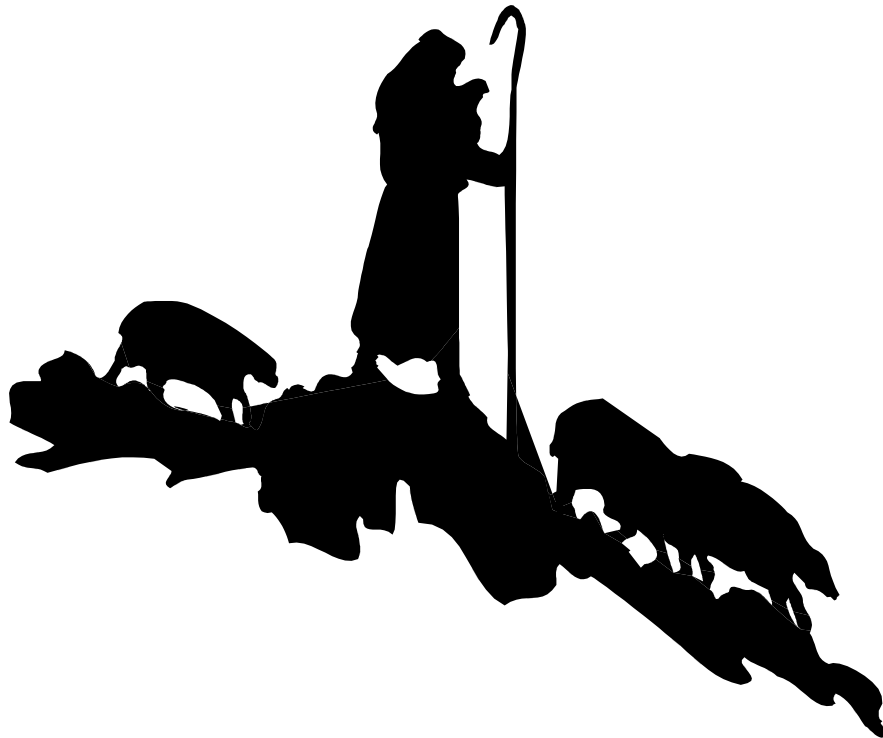
### Air (Soprano)

ye = you  
meek = gentle

heavy laden = have a heavy load  
burden = a load, something that is carried  
yoke = a bar with two pieces shaped like U's that fit around the necks of a pair of animals to link them together so that they can pull a load.
