

00 – Rereading Luke 12 **Luke 12: 1-59**

Step 1: Link (back to Part 5)

We are reading the story of Jesus in the book of Luke. We have read 12 chapters! We are ready to start reading chapter 13. But because some time has passed since we read chapter 12, we're going to reread chapter 12 today. So, our Bible time today will be a bit different than usual.

Step 2: Background (none needed)

Step 3: Key Questions

- **What is encouraging to you?** *(each will have their own response)*
- **What is difficult for you?** *(- ditto -)*

Notice that there are no right or wrong answers to these questions. Each of you will have your own answer, because these questions ask for your personal opinion.

Step 4: Read Luke 12: 1-59

They are probably used to reading one verse each; try to have them read 3-5 verses each, since this is so long.

Step 5: Answer the questions

Ask for volunteers to share their answers to the first question. Write "Encouragement" on the board, and list as many answers as they are willing to give. Do the same with "Difficulties/ Hard Truths."

Step 6: Talk about it (no need to, and probably no time)

Do you have any *other* questions or comments?

Teachers, it would be helpful to review the Bible times in chapter 12 in preparation for this section. However, don't feel constrained to have an answer for everything – there are mysteries too deep for that in the Bible. Always keep it as simple as possible (KI-ASAP, not as attractive as KISS, but we're aiming for KI ASAP. . .)
